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We normally use Don't or Doesn't to make a negative sentence in the simple present tense. Let's look at the difference between DON'T and DOESN'T. DON'T - Negative Sentences with DON'T in English We use Don't when the subject is I, you, we or they.

Don't and Doesn't in English - Simple Present Tense ...

Time Expressions in the Present Simple. The most common time expressions in the present simple are: usually, always, never, on Wednesdays, every Wednesday, twice a week, once a month, in general, every other day. Time expressions made up of one word are placed between the subject and the verb in positive sentences and questions and between the auxiliary verb and main verb in negative sentences.

The main verb (be) is conjugated in the Present Simple: am, are, is; For negative sentences, we insert not after the main verb. For question sentences, we exchange the subject and the main verb. How do we use the Present Simple tense? We use the Present Simple to talk about: general time (action verbs) situations now (stative verbs)

Negative sentences in the Present Perfect tense can be expressed in the form- (subject + have/has + NOT + third form of verb + an object) Rule for Negative Sentences in Present Perfect Tense: If the subject is - he, she, it or a singular noun then 'has' is used and followed by a 'not'.

Simple Present Tense indicates an action which happens in the present, but it isn't necessary for actions to happen right now. Simple present tense indicates, unchanging situations, general truths, scientific facts, habits, fixed arrangements and frequently occurring events. The Structures of Simple Present Tense.
