If α and β are the two roots of a quadratic equation, then the formula to construct the quadratic equation is $x^2 - (\alpha + \beta)x + \alpha\beta = 0$. That is, $x^2 - (\text{sum of roots})x + \text{product of roots} = 0$. If a quadratic equation is given in standard form, we can find the sum and product of the roots using coefficient of x^2 , x and constant term.. Let us consider the standard form of a quadratic equation,

Key Strategy in Solving Quadratic Equations using the Square Root Method. The general approach is to collect all $\{x^2\}$ terms on one side of the equation while keeping the constants to the opposite side. After doing so, the next obvious step is to take the square roots of both sides to solve for the value of x . Always attach the \pm symbol when you get the square root of the constant.
