Jean-Jacques Burlamaqui (1694-1748) is a prominent scholar of Natural Law and part of the Natural Law tradition of the Romandie of the 18th century, together with Jean Barbeyrac (1674-1744), Emer de Vattel (1714-1767) and Jean-Jacques Rousseau (1712-1778). A native Genevan, and a professor of civil law, Burlamaqui's works are strongly influenced by a Calvinist approach to government and public law and the emerging doctrines of natural law at the time.

Cicero's description of the immutable, eternal, and universal natural law was quoted by Burlamaqui and later by the American revolutionary legal scholar James Wilson. Cicero became John Adams 's "foremost model of public service, republican virtue, and forensic eloquence."
