In 59, Julius Caesar, Crassus, and Pompey concluded the First Triumvirate. The deal was confirmed by marriage; Pompey married to Caesar's daughter Julia. The Greek author Plutarch of Chaeronea describes this marriage in chapter 53 of his Life of Pompey. The translation below was made by Robin Seager.

[28.1] Caesar had long ago decided that Pompey must be removed from his position of power; and Pompey, for that matter, had come to just the same decision about Caesar. Crassus, who had been watching their struggle, ready to take on the winner himself, had been killed in Parthia; so that now the field was clear. The man who wanted to be on top had to get rid of the one who at present held that ...

Plutarch on Caesar and Pompey - Livius
